Post Traumatic Stress Disorders:

Features, Signs and Symptoms (Combat or Non-Combat Related)

- Features:
 - Extreme Traumatic Stressor involving direct personal experience of an event involves actual or threatened death or serious injury, witnessing an event that involves death or injury.
- Signs:
 - Intense Fear, helplessness or horror disorganized or agitated behavior.
- Symptoms:
 - Re-experiencing of the traumatic event, persistent avoidance of stimuli associated with the Trauma and numbing of general responsiveness.

Major Depression Disorder:

Features, Signs and Symptoms

- Features:
 - Depressed mood marked by anxiety for most days than not decreased in interest and activities which interfere with work, school or usual activities.
- Signs:
 - Poor appetite or over eating, can't sleep or sleeping too much, low-energy and poor concentration.
- Symptoms:
 - Feelings of hopelessness, difficulty making decisions.

Note: There are other characteristics, signs and symptoms associated with Post Traumatic Stress and Major Depression Disorders.
