

IMPACT PRESENTS TO VA CONFERENCE

Impact Services Veterans Services Department was one of several community service providers from across the nation selected to present a best practices model at the Homeward Bound Conference sponsored by the US Department of Veterans Affairs held in San Diego, CA on October 18th and 19th. The conference, held to mark the 20th Anniversary of the VA's focus on homeless veterans, brings together hundreds of VA professionals from across the country.
